#### New Essence Service Website Update



### **New Groups at Essence**

There are 2 new weekly groups at Essence. The groups will run at the same time every Wednesday 2pm – 3.30pm.

**The Gentlemen Carers Group** is a group specifically for male carers who will meet other men with similar caring roles for peer support, a friendly chat and some brief respite safe in the knowledge that their loved ones are supported in an activity in a nearby room.

The other group is called **The Lovely Ladies Group** which is for ladies who are 'cared for'. This is a supported group where there will be a range of varied activities the ladies can join in with and have an enjoyable afternoon

If you are a gentleman carer please come along it would be great to see you and your loved one (it is also fine if you want to come on your own).



### New Venue for our Tuesday Outreach Group

On Tuesday 8th February our Tuesday Outreach group moved to a new venue. The session will now be held in the Bistro area (ground floor) of the Holiday Inn in the city centre, one of the newest additions to the current development program in Sunderland. ### **Dementia Training Sessions**

#### Carers Only Dementia Training Session (1 afternoon session)

#### at The Essence Centre each second Friday on alternative months 1pm – 5pm

We are constantly developing our training provision from information gathered from feedback and the questionnaires we ask you to complete at certain times of the year (many thanks to everyone who contributed) and we understand some people may not be able to commit to courses which may take several weeks to complete due to demands in their caring role. As a result, we have put together a complete 'one-time' session which replaces previous training sessions we have provided.

The first session took place on Friday 13th January. There was a lot of positive feedback from the people who attended the session which gave them the opportunity to meet other carers in similar situations. Attendees were given an information booklet to accompany the training along with a certificate of attendance for completing the session.

Essence will be hosting these regular sessions at Sir Thomas Allen Centre, Doxford Park on each second Friday on alternative months April, June, August from 1pm – 5pm.



We continue to have our regular monthly Carers Forums that are held via Zoom on the first Wednesday of the month 9.30am–10.30am. If you would like to join us please contact Essence for further details.

#### Carer and Cared For Dementia Training Sessions (2 in total)

#### at The Essence Centre each second Friday on alternative months 2pm – 4pm

Due to carer need we will also be alternating the training dates with 2 consecutive weeks of a 2 hour session for carers who cannot leave their loved one for 4 hours.

The carer would come along to do the training in our activity room and their loved ones will be supported in the coffee lounge area at the same time.

Essence will be hosting these regular sessions at Sir Thomas Allen Centre, Doxford Park on each second Friday on alternative months March 10th & 17th, May July from 2pm – 4pm.

If you have a few hours spare on week days between the hours of 9.45am – 12 noon or 1.45pm – 4.30pm (depending on the session times), why not volunteer with the Essence Service.
